CRITIQUE GUIDELINES
October 2016 Club Critique

The purpose of a Critique is to offer constructive feedback on submitted images by advanced and/or expert members. PCoB holds two Club Critique sessions a year, in October and June. The October Critique is devoted to the images under consideration for the Annual Exhibit, which is hung in January. Participation in the October Critique is required prior to entering an image into our Annual Exhibit.

No photographer is required to make the suggested changes to his or her image. Should the feedback received during the Critique cause a photographer to withdraw the image from consideration for the Annual Exhibit, the photographer may contact the Chair of the Competition and Critique Committee and arrange to submit another image for the Exhibit.

The June Critique is held typically on an open theme, and should be viewed as an opportunity to gain feedback on any favorite image or one the photographer is considering for a future competition or exhibit.

The photographer should be present at the meeting where the images will be critiqued. If you can not be present, you may notify the Critique Chair that you will have a friend attend the Critique and take notes of the suggestions, if any, made to improve the image.

Submit images as jpeg files, 1500 x 1000 pixels maximum, file size no larger than 1 MB. Email your files to the following address: critiques@wk4j.net. You will receive an acknowledgement via email. If you do not receive an acknowledgment, please contact Lamar Nix, Assistant Competition and Critique Chair, lamarnix@gmail.com.

Label your images with your name, the title of the image, and the letter A or B. We will critique the images as a first (A) and second (B) round, as time permits. Be sure your favorite image is labeled "A" and the second image is labeled "B".
